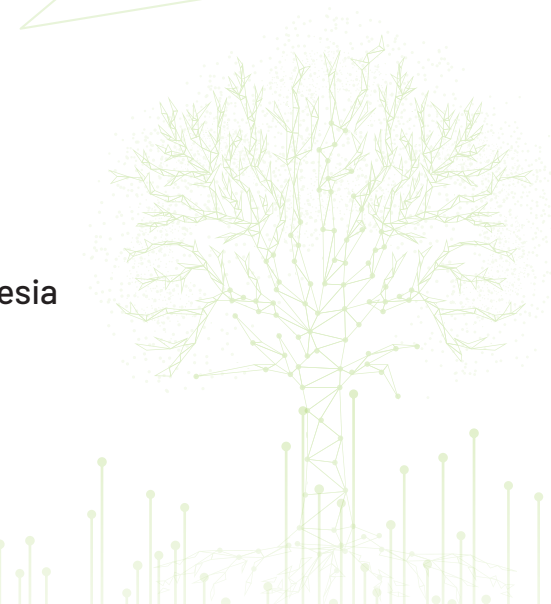

About CDC 2026



Carbon Digital Conference (CDC) 2026 will be held on 8–9 December 2026, bringing together carbon credit owners, project developers, regulators, investors, financial institutions, technology providers, corporate buyers and international partners to accelerate Indonesia's carbon market development.

Building on the success of previous CDC editions, the conference will focus on transforming carbon market opportunities into real commitments, investments and transactions. CDC 2026 comes at a pivotal moment following the enactment of Ministry of Forestry Regulation No. 6/2026, which establishes the framework for carbon trading through forestry sector greenhouse gas emission offsets and strengthens Indonesia's carbon market ecosystem.

Key discussions at CDC 2026 will include:

- Capacity Building & Global Market Readiness to strengthen project developers' ability to meet international buyer requirements and secure long-term offtake commitments.
- International Partnership Commitments with a special focus on collaboration opportunities involving Japan, South Korea and Singapore.
- Domestic Demand Creation through engagement with Indonesian corporations pursuing climate targets and sustainability commitments.
- Alternative Digital Financing solutions to support carbon project development and scale-up.
- Financial Industry Readiness covering the role of banks, investors, insurers and financial institutions in supporting carbon markets.

Why CDC 2026 Matters

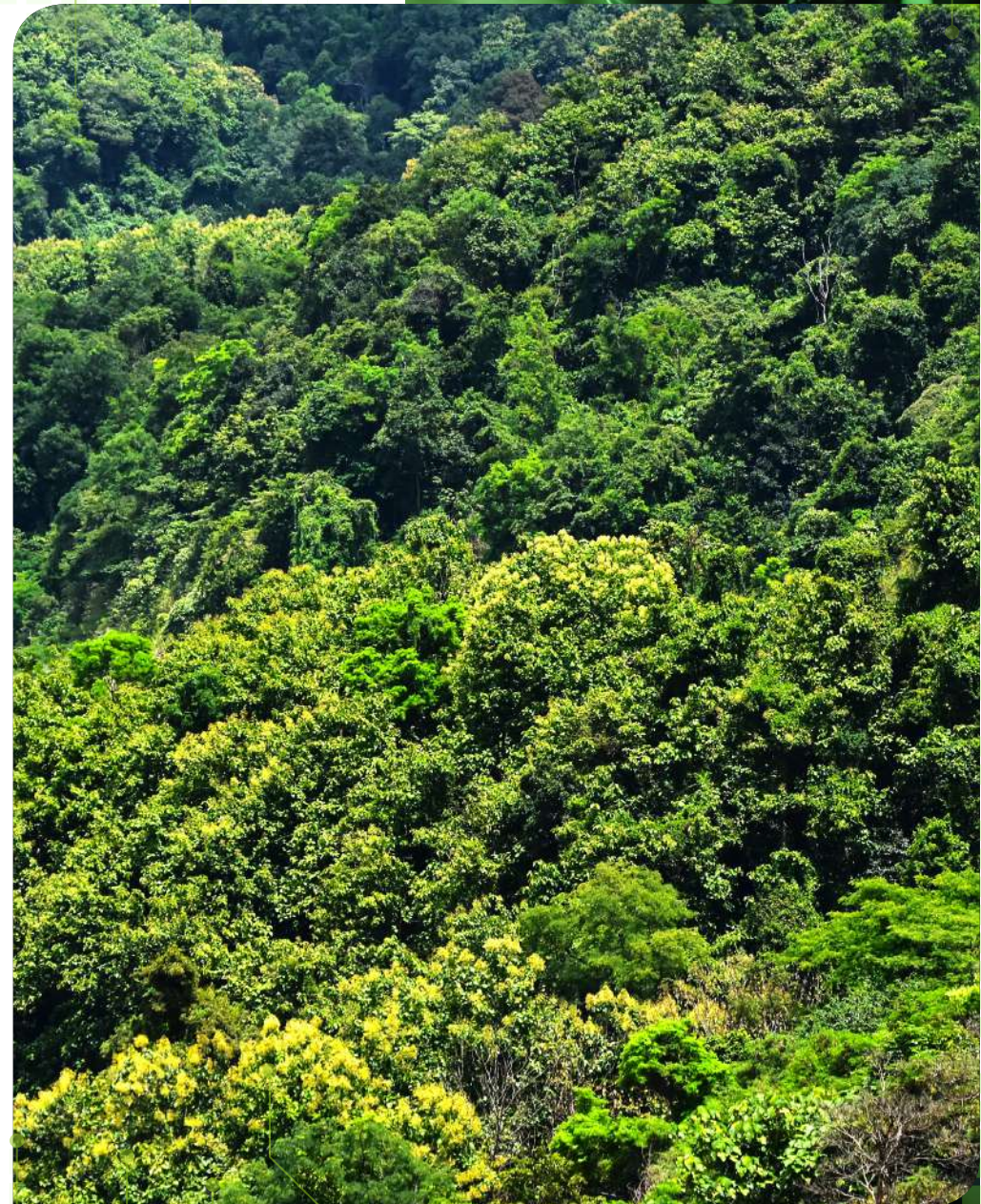

Connecting project owners, buyers, investors, technology partners and advisors to support high-quality carbon projects with environmental, social and economic benefits.

Event Objectives

1. Translate Indonesia's carbon and forestry regulatory developments into practical guidance for market actors.
2. Strengthen understanding of carbon trading, offset mechanisms, carbon unit registration, verification, authorization and market integrity.
3. Promote credible forestry carbon projects that support emission reduction, carbon absorption, biodiversity protection and community benefit sharing.
4. Showcase digital technologies that improve transparency, traceability, MRV quality and buyer confidence.
5. Build a meeting ground for project developers, corporate buyers, financial institutions, investors and solution providers.
6. Engage youth, researchers and innovators in shaping the future of Indonesia's carbon economy.

3. Digital MRV and Carbon Data Infrastructure

Technology showcases on satellite monitoring, remote sensing, AI, IoT, blockchain, digital registries, geospatial platforms and project-level monitoring tools.

4. Carbon Finance, Buyers and Offtakers

A business track for corporate buyers, investors, banks, insurers, exchanges, brokers and project developers to explore financing, offtake structures and long-term demand.

5. Communities, Social Forestry and Inclusive Carbon Value

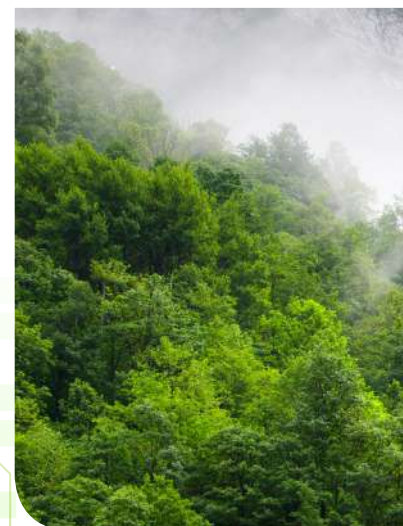
A dedicated space for local communities, social forestry groups, indigenous stakeholders and civil society to discuss participation, safeguards, governance and fair benefit distribution.

Leveraging digital technologies to improve monitoring, reporting, verification and the measurement of environmental and social co-benefits.

Highlighting the advancement of CCUS implementation and carbon sequestration in Indonesia.

The CYC 2025 Hackathon brought together innovators, mentors, judges, and sponsors to collaboratively develop forward-looking climate solutions. The program successfully fostered innovation, cross-sector collaboration, and emerging talents contributing to the next generation of environmental technology.

CDC History

Since its launch in 2023, Carbon Digital Conference has grown from an early-stage carbon market dialogue into one of Indonesia's most strategic annual platforms for carbon market collaboration. Hosted by the Indonesia Carbon Trade Association, IDCTA, CDC has consistently brought together the full carbon value chain: carbon asset owners, carbon project developers, investors, regulators, digital technology providers, carbon credit buyers and off-takers.

CDC is the annual flagship event of IDCTA, and CDC 2025 was officially positioned as the third year of the conference. The event connects leaders, innovators, policymakers, businesses and youth to accelerate Indonesia's transition toward a sustainable low-carbon economy.



2023: The Beginning of Indonesia's Carbon Market Convening Platform

Carbon Digital Conference 2023 was held on 8 to 10 November 2023 at The Apurva Kempinski, Bali. The event was organized by IDCTA together with members and domestic and international partners, with the objective of supporting Indonesia's Nationally Determined Contribution targets and the successful development of Indonesia's carbon exchange.

CDC 2023 established the foundation for a new kind of climate event in Indonesia: one that did not only discuss sustainability in general, but focused on the practical carbon market ecosystem. It created a meeting point for carbon stakeholders at a time when Indonesia was preparing its national carbon trading infrastructure.





2024: Expanding Into Finance, Digital MRV and Global Integrity

Carbon Digital Conference 2024 was held on 9 to 11 December 2024 at the Four Seasons Hotel, Jakarta. IDCTA's official history lists CDC 2024 as the second edition of the conference, following the 2023 Bali edition.

The 2024 theme, **"Reimagining Indonesia Carbon Market: Digital Innovations for Global Integrity,"** reflected the market's shift from awareness-building toward integrity, finance and technology. The program covered climate, legal, policy, finance and trade topics, including project developers and digital players, MRV standardization, AI and IoT for climate programs, carbon project contracts, financial services opportunities, carbon tax, investment in carbon projects from landowners to off-takers, digital exchange infrastructure and Indonesia's role in Asian carbon market development.

This edition strengthened CDC's position as a practical platform where project owners, investors, market infrastructure providers and regulators could discuss how Indonesia's carbon market should scale with credibility.





2025: Moving From Ambition to Implementation

Carbon Digital Conference 2025 was held on 7 to 10 December 2025 at the Bandung Institute of Technology, ITB, Bandung, according to IDCTA's official event history.

CDC 2025 carried the theme **"From Capture to Credit: Digital Pathways for Indonesia's Carbon Future."** The conference was presented as IDCTA's annual flagship event and its third year, with more than 300 attendees, more than 15 sub-themes and participation from companies, institutions and organizations.

The 2025 agenda showed CDC's evolution into a platform for implementation. Sessions included Indonesia's Carbon Market Key Regulatory Development for 2025, REDD+ Jurisdictional and Nested Systems Workshop, CO2 Injection Demo, Overview Regulation Landscape Update: Life After MRA, and CCS and CCUS sessions for oil and gas and non-oil and gas sectors.

CDC 2025 also aimed to bring together innovative digital players, carbon project developers, investors and carbon credit off-takers on a global scale, with sub-goals including optimizing Indonesia's carbon resources and market potential, ensuring high-integrity carbon projects through digital technology, and strengthening the role of non-state actors in voluntary carbon market discourse.
